### *Additional Information about Culture Camp 2012*

- **THEME:** The theme of this year's Culture Camp is Regions of China. We'll learn more about the history and traditions of different areas of China, including food, dance and China's ethnic minorities.
- **ACTIVITIES:** Activities for adults will include cooking, mahjong, the art of tea tasting, lectures and a trip to a Chinese grocery store. For the kids, activities will include crafts, scroll painting, singing and ribbon dancing. And for all, each day will start with tai chi morning exercises. Parents who are dropping off their children are welcome to stay for the tai chi before saying goodbye to their children for the day.
- **DUMPLING LUNCH ON MONDAY:** On the first day of camp, the registered adults will have a cooking activity making *jiaozi* (dumplings) and will make enough for all campers for lunch. So you don't need to bring a full lunch on Monday (but be sure to bring drinks and snacks).
- **COOKING:** Monday to Thursday, the adults cook recipes with Marion Ho. If you have any favourite recipes that you'd like Marion to teach, please indicate that on the registration form and we'll try to accommodate.
- **LUNCHROOM IS COLD!** If you have attended Culture Camp in past years, you know that the lunch room temperature can be chilly. The temperature is controlled by the library next door, so you might want to bring a sweater or jacket.
- **CHINESE LUNCH ON FRIDAY:** On Friday, we provide a hot Chinese lunch. The cost of the lunch is included in the registration fee for all campers. However, as in past years, you can invite other friends or family members to attend at an additional cost of \$13 per person. Early in the week of camp, you will be able to confirm whether there will be additional attendees for lunch and pay for them at that time.
- **BOOKSALE ON FRIDAY:** We are still working out the details, but possibly on Friday, a bookseller will be bringing in various books and other articles for sale.
- **PERFORMANCE:** As with prior years' Culture Camps, on the Friday afternoon of camp the children put on a performance. Please feel free to invite family members/friends to come and watch.
